INSTRUCTIONS:

- If you have drains, do not shower. Take sponge baths until seen in the office.
 - \circ The day the drains are removed, you may shower and wash the wounds with soap and water.
- If you do not have drains, you may shower 1-2 days after surgery.
- Keep head elevated while sleeping avoid sleeping on your side.
- Do not remove the steri-strip tape, but you may trim them if they start to lift off.
- Keep the dressing dry and clean.
- Wear a bra without any underwire at all times, even at night, for the first week. Do not wear a sports bra.
- No driving or housework for the first week. Do not lift your arms above your head. No exercise, straining or lifting until approved by Dr. Hoffman.
- You may return to work in about 1 week, unless otherwise specified by Dr. Hoffman.
- Call if you experience unusual pain, redness, swelling, bruising, bleeding or sustained fever.
