Avoid aspirin and Ibuprofen products. Do not drive or drink	while using this medication.

When you get home call Dr. Hoffman's office to schedule an	appointment on
<ul> <li>Ice packs to face 20 minutes at a time four times a day over</li> </ul>	the first 2-3 days
<ul> <li>Swelling and bruising can occur 2-3 days after procedure</li> </ul>	•
Keep head, neck, and shoulders elevated (including while sle	eeping)
<ul> <li>No straining, lifting, or bending for 1-2 weeks</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>No aspirin or ibuprofen for 5 days</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>No make-up until your stitches are removed</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Avoid exposure to sun, use sunscreen and hat</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Do not have any hair coloring treatment for 3 weeks after presented.</li> </ul>	rocedure
You may drive when you have been off of pain medications	and you feel comfortable
<ul> <li>You may resume light activity in 1 week, and more strenuou</li> </ul>	s activity after 2 weeks
<ul> <li>Call if you experience unusual pain, redness, swelling, bruisi</li> </ul>	ng, bleeding or sustained fever.
